**Order Modifying Deadline for Continuing Legal Education (CLE)  
Annual Fee and Late Fee**

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the deadline for payment of the 2019-2020 Supreme Court Rule 808(d) annual CLE fee is hereby modified to September 30, 2020.

Payment of the annual fee will be considered timely if submitted electronically no later than September 30, 2020, or remitted via U.S. mail postmarked no later than September 30, 2020. Annual fees submitted or remitted after that date will be considered delinquent and must be accompanied by a \$50 late fee.

Members of the bar of Kansas are reminded that an attorney who is required to file CLE credit hours and fails to do so, who fails to meet the minimum requirements of the CLE rules, or who fails to pay the annual fee and any applicable late fee may be administratively suspended from the practice of law under Rule 809.
