Until further order of the court, any oath or affirmation required or allowed by Rules of the Kansas Supreme Court may be administered:

1. In person;
2. Under K.S.A. 53-601 when applicable;
3. By any remote technology. Remote technologies include but are not limited to videoconferencing or teleconferencing; or
4. By the unsworn written declaration, verification, certificate or statement dated and subscribed by the person as true, under penalty of perjury, in substantially the following form:

(a) If executed outside this state: "I declare (or verify, certify or state) under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Kansas that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on (date).

(b) If executed in this state: "I declare (or verify, certify or state) under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on (date).
