Order Rescinding Annual Registration Fee Exemption for Federal Judges

The Administrative Order dated the 20th day of November 1979, which exempted active and retired judges of the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit and of the United States District Court for the District of Kansas from the annual registration fee, is rescinded.

Under Supreme Court Rule 206, an attorney admitted to the Kansas bar, including state and federal judges, must annually register with the Office of Judicial Administration, which includes payment of an annual registration fee. Attorneys who are exempt from the annual registration requirement are specified in Rule 206 and an attorney who fails to complete annual registration may be administratively suspended from the practice of law.
