Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the administrative judge and with the approval of the Judicial Administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above-designated holidays that the local county courthouse is open for business and observe as a substitute holiday a county-designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.

\*Whereas traditional observance of New Year's Day falls on Sunday, January 1, 1995 and whereas the State Executive Branch has designated Monday, January 2, 1995 as a holiday for this purpose, observance of this holiday shall be recognized on Monday, January 2, 1995.

\*\*Whereas traditional observance of Veterans Day falls on Saturday, November 11, 1995 and whereas the State Executive Branch has designated Friday, November 10, 1995 as a holiday for this purpose, observance of this holiday shall be recognized on Friday, November 10, 1995.
