COMMENCEMENT OF ACTIONS, PLEADINGS, AND RELATED MATTERS RULE 113 CLERK'S EXTENSION

Rule 113 is hereby amended, effective the date of this Order.

The clerk may extend <u>for a period of no more than 14 days</u> the initial time to plead to a petition under Chapter 60 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated for a period of no more than 14 days. in a civil action governed by the rules of civil <u>procedure</u>, other than an action commenced <u>pursuant</u> to the code of civil <u>procedure</u> <u>for limited actions.</u> The party seeking the extension must prepare an order for the clerk's signature, and copies must be served on all other parties. Any other extension of time to plead must be by court order.
