ORDER

Pursuant to K.S.A. 20-347, and due to the upcoming renovation of the Ellis County Courthouse and Law Enforcement Center, the 23rd Judicial District is hereby authorized to hold court elsewhere as follows:

Some Ellis County court offices will be relocated to 1205 Fort Street, Hays, including a magistrate court room and at least one court clerk;

Ellis County district judges and most of the court staff will be relocated to 3000 New Way, Hays.

Ellis County trials may be held in the Schenk Building at the Ellis County Fairgrounds, Hays, or in either Rooks County or Trego County, both within the 23rd Judicial District. Written consent of all parties is to be obtained if trials are moved out of Ellis County.

This order shall become effective as of December 1, 2014, and shall remain in effect until the renovation of the Ellis County Courthouse is complete.
