RULE 720

OATH

Rule 720 is hereby amended, effective April 2, 2015.

. . . .

(b) Unless otherwise permitted by the Supreme Court, an applicant shall take the oath of admission within one year after the date of the letter notifying an applicant that he or she has met the requirements under Rule 708, 709, 709A, or 712 for admission to the Kansas Bar. Failure to take the oath in the prescribed period will result in revocation of the letter of licensure.
